Program Structure:

The Boaz City Schools 21st Century Community Learning Center Extended Day Program is committed to providing a quality program that provides engaging learning activities in a safe and supportive environment, with a balance of recreational, enrichment, and educational activities.

It provides a safe, educational climate where children may remain for a limited time at the end of the regular school day until picked up by their parents or other designated adults. It also offers a broad array of activities such as drug and violence prevention education, counseling, art, music, recreation, technology, and character education programs.

The Extended Day Program is designed to address the child's social, physical and intellectual needs. The program is structured, but also allows children the freedom to choose and to participate in a variety of activities. The program will vary from school to school, according to the interests of the children and the talents of the staff. All programs will include homework time, snack time, recreational activities and enrichment activities.

Extended Day Guidelines and Procedures:

Purpose:

The purpose of the Extended Day Program is to provide parents with a safe and enriching environment in which their school children may receive supervised care after school for a designated time. The program will offer academic, artistic, and cultural enrichment activities to students and families when school is not in session.

Parental Involvement:

The Extended Day Program promotes partnerships with parents to benefit children emotionally, socially, and meet community needs.

Procedures

Discipline:

Standard of conduct is the same as for the regular school day. Failure to comply with rules of conduct can result in the child being dismissed from the program.

Time:

2:45 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Children will be received at 2:45 p.m. and should be picked up no later than 5:30 p.m. Failure to pick up children on time may result in termination of services for the children and a charge of \$1.00 per minute, payment in cash, upon pick up of child.

Registration:

Parents may register their child for Extended Day any time during the regular school year. There will be an opportunity to pre-register your child during the school pre-registration.

Eligibility:

Students currently in kindergarten through 13 years of age are eligible for the program.

Financing:

The Extended Day Program is a self-sustaining program.

Tuition:

- Weekly fee is due in advance.
- Delinquency of more than two weeks will result in dismissal of child.
- Make checks payable to the Extended Day Program your child attends.
- A service charge of \$29.00 will be assessed for returned checks and cash payments for further services will be mandatory.
- A separate fee may be required if extra classes are offered. An example would be a special dance or music class.

The Following Rates Apply:

1 Child	\$32.00 per week
2 Children	\$52.00 per week
3 Children	\$67.00 per week
Drop-ins	\$ 10.00 per day
Registration Fee:	\$25.00 per family (Non-Refundable)

Note: Further fees:

- **Late pick-ups \$1.00 per minute**
- **No price adjustment for early pick up.**

Snacks:

A snack will be provided by the program daily.
