- Must be enthusiastic, motivated and to be able to work in both an upbeat team environment as well as under minimum supervision
- If you are 18 years or older, you must complete the fingerprinting and background check process
- Able to climb stairs and lift up to 50 pounds
- Be able to relate to adults and children with respect, patience and compassion and enforce boundaries and limits
- Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable

- Practice techniques suited specifically for each student's unique needs and learning styles
